

Youth Activity Incident Escalation Decision Tree

An incident of concern may have occurred

*This includes incidents directly witnessed,
rumors about incidents,
and threats of future incidents*

Call 911 if you are in immediate danger or there is a
life-threatening situation.

Ensure the safety of youth participants and staff.



Does the alleged incident fall under [Child Abuse or Neglect](#), [Sexual Harassment or Sexual Violence](#), [Clery Crimes on Campus Geography](#), [Accidental Injury](#) and/or [ATCP 78](#) laws or policies that require reporting?

Complete appropriate report(s) and escalate information about alleged incident within your school, college, or division.

Escalation conversations may start prior to submission of the report(s)

Does the alleged incident raise serious concerns about the safety or well-being of youth participants or staff (e.g., bullying, concerns that require ongoing involvement with parents/guardians)?
